Terry Stott Retires

By the time this newsletter is published, Terry Stott will be waking up without an alarm clock and casually enjoying her morning coffee.

After 28+ years of dedicated service to Hospice of Spokane, Terry retired from Hospice of Spokane this past August. She served more than 27 of those years as Director of Nursing Services.

"When I first came to Hospice of

Spokane, we were serving around 45 patients a day," Terry reminisced. "We wore pagers and relied on pay phones to call the office, and we did paper charting after patient visits. Today, we are serving close to 300 patients a day, we have cell phones for ease of communication, and we use electronic records and laptops for charting."

What hasn't changed is the caliber of team members who are providing hospice care. When asked what it takes to be a hospice nurse, Terry was quick to reply, "You have to know how to listen and be present for your patients and their families, you have to have a sense of humor, and you must have a passion for the work."

Terry came from a family of nurses. "My grandmother and mother had both been nurses, and I chose that same pathway," said Terry. After two years at WSU and remaining a loyal "Coug" to this day, she transferred to the Intercollegiate School of Nursing where she completed her degree.

Terry has had a distinguished nursing career. Her first nursing position was in the acute care psych ward at Sacred Heart Hospital, where she worked for two years. Her husband's job had taken her to Ellensburg for a couple of years, where they had their daughter, Elizabeth.

MESSAGE FROM THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER Keeping Perspective

Our patients and families teach us so much: the importance of gratitude, grace and perspective. Working with patients and families who are experiencing terminal illness has a way of reminding us of what's important.

As an organization, we've had to stay focused on what's most important as we've experienced the challenges of the pandemic and the inflation and workforce issues that followed. Sustaining two hospice houses became harder and harder for us to do, leading to

the necessary decision to close and sell the North House. This has been difficult for our Board, team members, volunteers, donors and community members. No one wanted to see this happen.

Many of you have been aware of this decision for some time, and for some of you, this may be the first you've heard of it. The staffing challenges, increased operational costs and increased Medicare scrutiny made for the necessary decision to close the North House, but knowing it was necessary didn't make it any easier. We are reminded that the mission has to be our focus. Dr. Johnny Cox, (our Board Member Emeritus) has reminded us, "Don't let a ministry within the organization, compromise our mission." Cornering the market on "where" patients die was never our goal. It will always be about the "how"— providing care with compassion, dignity and respect in whatever setting the patient calls home.

Our founders came together in 1976 in an effort to create an organization that would support patients and families experiencing terminal illness in our community. We were primarily a volunteer operation at the time because there was no reimbursement for services, until 1983. We can be so proud of our humble beginnings and of the clear mission that our founders set before us. We will stay true to this mission, for the sake of our community and the lives of our community members.

Hospice 101 - The Basics of Hospice Care



We are often asked to do presentations for our long-term care facilities, hospitals, educational settings, and other organizations throughout our community. Sometimes the request is very specific regarding desired content but most of the time, the request is for "Hospice 101." The broad overview of what hospice provides and the difference hospice can make is generally what organizations are most interested in learning. It's good to remind our community members from time to time what that entails. Here are a few of the basics about hospice care:

- Hospice is for anyone of any age who is experiencing terminal illness and is no longer pursuing active treatment.
- The focus of our care is on comfort. Our goal is to maximize the quality of life that an individual has for as long as that's possible.
- Our goal also, is to support the family and provide the education and guidance necessary for them to feel comfortable providing care to their loved one.
- We serve patients in all types of settings including their home, the home of a friend or family member, the hospital, long-term care facility and at the Hospice House.

- We serve patients with any end stage disease process which can include end stage lung disease, end stage cardiac disease, end stage liver or kidney disease as well as neurodegenerative disorders. We also serve many patients with an end stage cancer diagnosis. There are also many patients who are admitted because they are declining overall, losing weight, falling, and are perhaps experiencing recurrent infections, etc.
- Hospice of Spokane also serves infants and children with a terminal illness and some of these children have been born with congenital anomalies.
- Our focus for every patient we serve is on care, not cure. Our job is to help the patient and family achieve as much comfort, as much dignity and as much peace as they can possibly have.
- Our care is provided by a multi-disciplinary team comprised of physicians, nurses, nurse practitioner, social workers, nurse aides, as well as chaplains and volunteers. We also utilize PT, OT and Speech Therapy when that's needed.

The patient and family are the unit of care. This is their journey. Our job is to help them achieve the best quality of life possible, for as long as that's possible, and to be prepared for every step along the way.

Scrambling for Hospice Led to a Successful Event!

As part of our fundraising event, we sell Compassion Cards that provide the golfer with four "cheats" per card: Throw the ball, kick the ball, and take a mulligan. For the men, they could choose a hole to tee off from the women's tee box. For the women, they got one extra throw, kick or mulligan. We also sold string for \$5/foot. With the string, golfers could move their ball the length of the string that much closer to the hole and save a stroke or two. These fundraising gimmicks provided a bit of help to our winning team scores of 39 for the men's team, 43 for the mixed team and 49 for the women's team. They also added to the day's fun and additional fundraising opportunities. This, along with a Silent Auction and Golden Ticket Raffle made for a very successful event.

After returning to Spokane, Terry worked at Southcrest Skilled Nursing for five years and as Director of Nursing at St. Luke's for ten years.

Terry began her career with Hospice of Spokane in 1995. When asked what drew her to hospice care, Terry explained, "It was during the Kübler Ross era when I was in nursing school, and I was very interested in learning more about end-of-life care. That, coupled with my first-hand experience with hospice, I knew it was the place for me."

One of Terry's favorite things about hospice care was IDT Meetings. Interdisciplinary Team Meetings (also known as care conferences) are held weekly with interdisciplinary teams of staff where each patient's care is reviewed and discussed. "Everyone wants to help, and everyone is valued as equals around the table. It's about the patient and what they want and need," explained Terry.

One of Terry's favorite quotes is, "I love it when a plan comes together," by Mr. T. Terry commented that it reminds her of care conference. She keeps a poem about IDT meetings displayed in her office, which we've shared in this newsletter. It has served as a constant reminder of the power of team and the patient being at the center of our work.

Terry has been a valued leader and mentor to so many of the nurses with whom she's worked over the years. One such nurse is Christina Kush. "One of the many things I have appreciated about Terry is how she assumes and expects the best of her nurses. I've always treasured the tacit confidence she has placed in me," commented Christina.

What will Terry miss? "The people, the patients and their stories," she replied. "So many patients and their stories, and so many amazing team members who I've enjoyed working with over the years."

What will we miss about Terry? "Terry's strong work ethic, leadership skills, and her unwavering commitment and passion for serving our patients and their families, said CEO Gina Drummond. "She will be deeply missed."
