

Our Beloved Dr. Novan

Dr. George Novan is a well-known physician in the local healthcare system and medical education programs in our area, pioneering the growth of our medical campus here in Spokane, WA. Hospice of Spokane has been honored and fortunate to have Dr. Novan on our Board of Trustees since 2016. His priceless contribution to the board includes his expertise as an infectious disease physician, which helped guide our staff and facilities through the pandemic.

As a man who has spent his life serving others in medicine and education, Dr. Novan came from humble beginnings, restarting his life several times before the age of 18. George Novan was born in 1947 in Bratislava, Czechoslovakia (now the Slovak Republic). After World War II, the country was under Soviet control. Dr. Novan's parents fled the country, escaping across the border with smuggled passports, leaving behind everything. His mother and father settled in Paris, France, restarting their lives near family. Years later, the French government gave non-citizens the choice of going back to their homeland or leaving for another country. If they decided to return to their native soil, Dr. Novan's father would have been imprisoned by the communists, so the only option was to relocate someplace new. Australia was taking anyone with a college degree, so that is where they went, becoming Australian citizens and calling a small suburb in Sydney home until Dr. Novan turned 13.

Longing to be near family and unable to return to any country under the Soviet Iron Curtain, where most of their family resided, the Novan's packed up once more, moving to the United States and settling in Glendale, CA, where Dr. Novan's aunt and uncle lived. It was in Glendale where Dr. Novan finished junior high and high school.

Paying it Forward

my duties is to educate
the public and

There are two parts to medical education: medical school, which constitutes four years of education that all

physicians undertake, and medical residency. Medical residency is the training a physician undergoes after medical school to specialize in a specific field, such as family medicine or surgery. It is surprising that neither medical school nor residency programs require any training in hospice care. There is so much time spent on treating and curing illnesses, and no time allotted for learning how to provide comfort for those at the end of their lives, when cure is no longer a possibility. Since we will all, at some point, die, it seems logical that hospice and end-of-life care should be considered integral to medical education.

I'm pleased to report that in Spokane, the two largest residency programs recognize the benefit of educating their residents about hospice care. Both the Family Medicine and Internal Medicine residency programs encourage their residents to spend time with Hospice of Spokane to learn about hospice and end-of-life care.

The time spent with Hospice of Spokane is very valuable. It provides our physicians in training with a foundation in hospice care and exposure to patients at the end of life.

A resident's main interaction with death and dying occurs in the hospital when a patient is taken off life support or when they are called upon to perform CPR on a patient in cardiac arrest. A death under these circumstances is usually traumatic in contrast to a peaceful death with family and loved ones by the patient's side in a hospice setting.

Resident's who have knowledge of hospice services are more empathetic when it comes to dealing with their patients. They understand the importance of not only treating the disease, but also accommodating the emotional, spiritual, and psychosocial needs of patients and their families. This education broadens their perspectives and exposes them to a more holistic form of care that is not just focused on curing disease but promoting overall comfort and dignity during the last phase of life, influencing how they approach medicine in their future practices.

They are exposed to the hospice model of working in an interdisciplinary team, including doctors, nurses, social workers, and chaplains. This team-based approach enhances collaboration and coordination that is valuable across many medical disciplines.

At Hospice of Spokane, we understand that educating medical providers is a critical part of our mission. While learning how to treat diseases is important, it's equally crucial to realize that care does not cease when a cure is no longer attainable. Incorporating hospice education into a resident's training is the best way to guarantee high-quality end-of-life care for future generations.

Hospice of Spokane was founded by a group of dedicated volunteers in 1977 and has served our community for more than 45 years. Volunteers still form the backbone of our organization. They help in many ways, including in clients' homes, senior living facilities, in our office, or out in the community.

After graduation, he attended University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) where he earned his bachelor's degree in Zoology and his medical degree. During this time, he also became a US citizen.

Dr. Novan spent his residency at University of California, Irvine (UCI) and completed his fellowship for Infectious Disease at the UCI Medical Center. Following his fellowship, Dr. Novan met his wife, Chyrl, an ICU nurse. From 1978-1990, Dr. Novan and Chyrl lived in Orange County, CA, had two children, with a medical career that included private practice, serving as faculty at UCI and being Director of Internal Medicine Residency Program at one of UCI's affiliate hospitals.

In 1990, while reading a medical journal, Chyrl saw a job posting for the Internal Medicine Residency Program Director at Providence Sacred Heart Medical Center in Spokane, WA. With the hopes of leaving Southern California for a smaller, slower paced city, Dr. Novan travelled to Spokane, applied for the position, interviewed, and received a job offer within two weeks.

Since Spokane's internal residency program was affiliated with the University of Washington School of Medicine, part of the initial application process was to be interviewed by the UW's Department of Medicine chairman. During that interview, the chairman asked if Dr. Novan would like to have UW medical students train with his residents in Spokane. He jumped at the chance, which lead to him becoming UW's Internal Medicine Clerkship Coordinator for Spokane.

WSU and UW School of Medicine worked together to establish a first-year medical school program as part of UW's multistate regional medical school training. Dr. Novan was asked to be the Associate Director of that program at WSU Spokane. As WSU grew and realized the state would benefit from having two independent

medical schools in the state, it broke away from UW and created the Elson S. Floyd WSU College of Medicine. Dr. Novan was part of that creation process and continued there in both teaching and administrative roles until retiring in 2018.

Since retiring, Dr. Novan still enjoys being a guest lecturer at the WSU Spokane Medical School for first year medical students and when the weather is warmer, you may find him at his cabin in North Idaho, kayaking around the lake or playing with his dog down by the water. He also takes pleasure in spending time with his family and grandkids.

Dr. Novan would also like to continue his travels, visiting the places he once called home. His trip back to the Slovak Republic last year allowed him to visit the hospital where he was born, his first home and reconnect with long lost relatives. Dr. Novan is enjoying a slower pace in his retirement. He continues to read various medical publications and enjoys tinkering with computers; activities that use his hands and challenge his brain.

While working at Sacred Heart, Dr. Novan met Johnny Cox, a founder of Hospice of Spokane, who was working as an ethicist for the hospital. The two quickly became great friends and this relationship is what ultimately steered Dr. Novan to serve on the Board of Trustees for Hospice of Spokane. Dr. Novan thoroughly enjoys working with nonprofits and says being a board member for Hospice of Spokane "has been a joy to be a part of. The board has some wonderful members; very bright, concerned, and altruistic people, full of great ideas." As we move into 2024, Dr. Novan enters his final year on the Hospice of Spokane Board.

We have treasured our time with Dr. Novan and his time with us has had tremendous impact. He is beloved in our organization and community. We are blessed to have had this time with him.
